RUGGLES CENTER MASTER PLAN BOSTON, MASSACHUSETTS

This 850,000 square foot, mixed-use development was planned for a six acre site adjacent to the Ruggles Street Transit Station at Northeastern University. Its landscaped central plaza is on axis with the principal station facade and is conceived as a hub of pedestrian and vehicular activity. Pedestrian-oriented activities along Columbus Avenue and Tremont Street will make these streets attractive places for shopping and strolling.

Departing from the current scale and intensity of surrounding land uses, the structures at Parcel 18 have been designed to provide a lively destination marking the revitalization of this section of the city. S+L designed this transit station, the adjacent 950 car parking garage and the 200,000 S.F. Renaissance office building.
